For good cause determined at the October 25, 2016 public meeting of the Commonwealth Casino Commission, which was duly publicly noticed, and based on the authority granted by the laws of the Commonwealth and the Regulations of the Commonwealth Casino Commission, NMIAC Chapter 175-10.1, the Commonwealth Casino Commission hereby **ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The minimum bankroll requirements of §175-10.1-560 are hereby suspended subject to the requirements enumerated in sections (2) - (6) inclusive, listed below.
2. The Licensee must, by December 1, 2016, provide to the Commission a corporate resolution from its parent company guaranteeing the payment of all gambling debts of the licensee, without reservation or limitation.
3. The parent corporation submits itself irrevocably to the jurisdiction of the courts of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
4. The Licensee must provide an attorney opinion from counsel acceptable to the Executive Director which opines that the resolution referenced in (2) above has been legally promulgated, and legally binds the corporation to pay all gaming debts of the licensee without reservation.
5. The funds must be available to be paid as ordered by the Commonwealth Casino Commission through its Executive Director.
6. The suspension is effective beginning October 26, 2016 and shall last until the day before gaming commences at the Grand Mariana Project (Imperial Pacific Resort), after which the Regulation shall again take effect without further action of the Commission.
